#### What Will I Explore and Learn?

##### Language and Literacy

Listening & Speaking – I will begin to understand more complex concepts, use language to communicate my needs and ideas and listen to others.

##### Reading

Comprehension-I will ask and answers questions about the books we explore in our classroom.

Fluency-My teachers will listen closely to how I speak and express myself.

Print Concepts-I will learn about book titles and authors.

Phonological Awareness-I will explore syllables.

Letter and Word Recognition-I will “read” familiar words and print in my classroom environment.

Writing – My teachers will observe how I grasp and hold a variety of writing tools.

##### Math

Exploration of Materials- I will observe and name the colors, shapes, sizes, textures and other attributes of materials.

Number Sense-I will begin to count and identify written numbers.
